

## PDF WITH CORRECTIONS METRIC MEASUREMENTS

### CUTTING THE PIECES TO MAKE THE BAG



#### IMPERIAL

##### RAZZLEBERRY CARDSTOCK

Bag Body 5" x 12"  
Side panels 6" x 2.5" ( each)  
Handle 1/2" x ( desired length)  
Bag Bottom reinforcement 1-1/2" x 5"

##### VERY VANILLA CARDSTOCK

Pieces for the inside of the bag  
2 PCS 5" x 3 1/4"  
1 Piece 5" x 2-1/4"

#### METRIC

##### RAZZLEBERRY CARDSTOCK


Bag Body 12.7 x 29.7 cm  
Side panels 15 x 6cm ( each)  
Handle 2.2cm x ( desired length)  
Bag Bottom reinforcement 4x15cm

##### VERY VANILLA CARDSTOCK

Pieces for the inside of the bag  
2 PCS 12.7x 8cm  
1 Piece 12.7x 6cm

## PDF WITH CORRECTIONS METRIC MEASUREMENTS

### SCORING THE BODY OF THE BAG



FIND MEASUREMENTS FOR SCORING LINES IN THE CHARTS BELOW.

USE "**SIMPLE SCORED**" BY STAMPIN' UP! TO ACHIEVE CRISP SCORING LINES.



## USE DETAILED FLORAL THINLITS DIES TO CREATE AN SPECTACULAR DIE CUT PATTERN



Place the dies with the irregular border facing the carstock edges as shown in the pictures. Pay special attention where to place the dies regarding the scoring lines.



## FINISHING THE BAG MAIN PANEL...




The panel has been completely die cut. Now rim the excess cardstock in the bag flap using sharp paper snips.



NOTE: Don't worry if you place the dies in opposite direction this will be fine also. You will get a straight edge on the bag flap by placing the die with the straight side facing the edge,. Very cool too!

## FOLD THE PAPER OVER THE SCORING LINES



## MAKING THE THE SIDES PANELS OF THE BAG



Place and score the piece as shown in the picture above.



Fold this piece to find the centre  
and cut it to get the 2 identical side panels

## FOLD AND PASTE THE BAG SIDE PANELS AND ADD THE BAG BOTTOM REINFORCEMENT



Trim the side panels as shown in the **first picture above** and fold the scoring lines.

Paste the panels to the bottom of the bag making sure they are perfectly aligned with the side edges ( *as shown in the video* )

To finish paste on top the bag bottom reinforcement piece.

\*\*\*\*At this point do not paste the bag side panels to the main panels of the bag (only on the base). If you prefer you can skip this step and paste the sides of the bag after finishing die cutting the whole project.

## ADD THE BAG LINING



Apply glue to paste the bag lining. Avoid excessive use of glue.

Note: Adding lining is completely optional but it is recommended to add stability to the die cut area.



Then die cut the top edge of the bag.  
Use washi tape to hold the die in place.

## PASTE THE BAG HANDLE



Use a strong glue to paste the handle over the right side of the bag. I used Tomobow multipurpose glue and I was tempted to use brads as well.



Trim the handle to desired length.

## PASTE THE BAG SIDE PANELS



Aligned the edges of all parts and paste with double sided tape



## ADD MAGNETS



To keep the bag closed you can paste magnets  
( 1/2" / 1cm diameter magnets) using a  
very strong double sided tape or a very strong adhesive.

## ADD EMBELLISHMENTS ...



Add A wow factor to this projects by using flower punches, Rhinestones, Thread or ribbon embellishments.


